Conference Schedule:

The two-day conference will begin on Friday with visits to local schools. All participants must register for these visits and indicate preference of elementary, middle, or high school visits. Saturday's schedule will include a key note address by the University of Massachusetts Boston Distinguished Professor, **Dr. Donaldo Macedo**. Dr. Macedo has co-authored a number of books and articles with influential world-renowned thinkers like Noam Chomsky, Howard Zinn, and Paulo Freire. Macedo, a founder of critical literacy, is known as the country's leading Freirean scholar. Also speaking on Saturday is **Dr. Margarita Luna-Delgado**. Dr. Luna-Delgado was Coordinator of Graduate Education Programas at Universidad Iberoamericana, and is a cofounder of the Border Pedagogy Initiative. Simultaneous translation to English or Spanish will be available. Concurrent research and best practice sessions will be scheduled at times to be determined.
