- ◆ Teach (through face-to-face, online, and hybrid delivery models at the main campus and regional campuses), advise, and mentor students in our MAT Program and other LFCE programs as deemed appropriate
- ◆ Demonstrate scholarly productivity by publishing in peer-reviewed journals and presenting at national conferences
- ◆ Implement the strategic vision and mission of the University and LaFetra College of Education
- ◆ Actively contribute as an integral member of the faculty in the ongoing development, implementation, and assessment of the overall program
- ◆ Serve as program/department/college representative at the College and University level and with community partners

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- The successful candidate will have professional experience commensurate with the role of assistant professor as documented by the following:
- ◆ An earned doctorate in Education or a related field
 - ◆ Currency in the field documented by at least 3 years' experience as a credentialed PK-12 teacher
 - ◆ A record of scholarly research publications and presentations
 - ◆ Experience working with and advocating for diverse and underrepresented student populations
 - ◆ Demonstrated commitment to social justice and culturally responsive teaching
 - ◆ Record of commitment to community engagement activities
 - ◆ Excellent communication and interpersonal skills, with strong leadership capabilities, including a demonstrated commitment to integrity and fairness
 - ◆ Knowledge of current pedagogy and significant skill in teaching in an online environment.

- ◆ Experience in urban and/or rural educational settings is highly desired
- ◆ Current knowledge of teacher preparation and related programs in California
- ◆ Familiarity with pursuing external funding
