Dr. Kevin K. Kumashiro

Kevin Kumashiro is an internationally recognized expert on educational policy, school reform, teacher preparation, and educational equity and social justice. He is the former Dean of the School of Education at the University of San Francisco (2013-2017). He is an author and editor of several books, including *"Troubling Education"* (recipient of the 2003 Gustavus Myers Outstanding Book Award), and *"Against Common Sense: Teaching and Learning toward Social Justice"*. He is a founding member of EDJE (Education Deans for Justice and Equity), CARE-ED (California Alliance of Researchers for Equity in Education), and CReATE (Chicagoland Researchers and Advocates for Transformative Education). Kumashiro received his Ph.D. from the University of Wisconsin at Madison.
