- Demonstrating and employing digital tools that enhance learning in all courses.

- Demonstrated commitment to TK-12 Literacy.
- Understanding of Common Core State Standards and its integration into content areas.
- Commitment to urban education, diversity, inclusion, and student academic and social excellence.
- Evidence of exemplary teaching in a university settings.
- Demonstrated ability to use a variety of instructional methodologies.
- Willingness and ability to work collaboratively with colleagues.
- Knowledge and successful integration of technology in planning and teaching.
- A publication agenda related to English Language Arts and Literacy.
- Expertise in English language learning theories, practice, and pedagogy.
 - Experience in teaching students from diverse age, socioeconomic, cultural, and academic backgrounds.
