Job Description:

This is a tenure-track position in the Education Department. The primary responsibilities include teaching early childhood and child development courses in areas of expertise, supervising student teachers, student advisement, program coordination and direction, oversight of adjunct faculty teaching in the programs, and continued development of professional expertise as a teacher educator.

The successful candidate must hold an earned doctorate (ABD will be considered) in Child Development or closely related field, a minimum of three years experience in a work setting related to child development, and hold or be eligible for a California Child Development Teacher Permit (supervisors permit preferred). Experience with children and families and college teaching preferred. Applicants must be able to demonstrate teaching excellence, commitment to students, dedication to the education of diverse students, and the ability to work collaboratively. Faculty of color especially encouraged to apply.

Applicants are to complete the online application and submit vita, cover letter, official transcripts, and the names and phone numbers of three references by January 22, 2017.
