The successful candidate will be responsible for teaching courses at the post-baccalaureate and MA levels; included are elementary and/or secondary methods, courses in the MA in Education (Curriculum & Instruction specialization), as well as supervising teacher candidates in the field. Position may include the teaching of courses at the undergraduate level. Additional tenure-track responsibilities include developing, maintaining or expanding a scholarly research agenda and service to the program, university, and community.

Required Qualifications:

- Doctoral degree in Education or a related field.
- Record of successful credentialed K-12 school teaching for a minimum of three years, with demonstrated effectiveness in teaching multi-ethnic, multicultural and/or multi-lingual students using a variety of methods and technologies.
- Commitment to student success and diversity.
- Record of positive relationships with school district personnel, students, and families.
- Evidence of commitment and ability to work in teams.
- An emerging record of scholarship in one or more areas of emphasis in education.
- Evidence of commitment to one's own discipline and to the broader institution.
- As a condition of employment, this position will require a background check. The person holding this position is considered a 'mandated reporter' under the California Child Abuse and Neglect Reporting Act and is required to comply with the requirements set forth in CSU Executive Order 1083 as a condition of employment.

Preferred Qualifications:

- Experience teaching in a Spanish bilingual K-12 setting.
- Doctoral specialization in History/Social Science/Social Studies Education.
- Background in Social Science (e.g., Chicano Studies, Ethnic Studies, Gender Studies, Western History, Mexican/American History, etc.)
- Experience working with students with special learning needs.
- Experience collaborating and/or co-teaching with related service providers.
- Experience in and commitment to ongoing, outcomes-based, program assessment of teaching and learning.
- Professional expertise and demonstrated excellence in teaching methods courses and clinical practice supervision at the university level.
- University level experience in curriculum planning and development.
- Knowledge of regional and/or national accreditation processes and preparation of required documentation.
- Experience in on-line or blended teaching and course development.
- Record of grant and contract acquisition.
