

Teacher Education Position Announcement

The School of Education, University of California, Davis invites applications for the position of Lecturer/ Supervisor of Teacher Education in the Multiple Subjects program. This is expected to be a full-time, non-tenure track yearly appointment with potential for renewal on a year by year basis, as allowed per the UC-AFT Memorandum of Understanding. Appointment begins Summer of 2016. Successful candidates will 1) possess appropriate academic preparation and professional experience to teach undergraduate and graduate curriculum and instruction courses in our Teacher Education program, 2) supervise student teachers in elementary schools for the credential/MA program, and 3) have experience in and knowledge of teaching and learning issues and current school contexts in California public schools.

Minimum Qualifications:

The candidate must 1) hold a Master's degree or above with emphasis in education, 2) have taught in the elementary context for a minimum of 3 years, 3) hold or be eligible for a California Multiple Subject Teaching Credential, 4) have experience working with culturally/linguistically diverse communities in ways consistent with the mission of the UC Davis School of Education.

Preferred Qualifications:

The preferred candidate will possess: 1) an earned Doctorate in Education, 2) experience with curriculum development, RICA edTPA, literacy instruction, 3) experience with field supervision/and or mentoring pre service or novice teachers and 4) strong evidence of an inquiry stance toward teaching and teacher education.

Responsibilities include:

- supervise education student teachers in linguistically and culturally diverse classroom placements and other field experiences;
- teach credential/MA classes;
- mentor student or novice teachers;
- participate in student advising, committee work, and in developing and maintaining university/school teacher education partnerships;
- participate in regular programmatic planning meetings within Teacher Education and the broader School of Education
- collaborate with Teacher Education and other School of Education faculty to engage in inquiry about teacher education and support the research mission of the University of California

Salary
