Associate Dean of Accreditation School of Education

The Associate Dean oversees the use of LiveText, the unit's assessment management system, and works closely with the Teacher Accreditation Department and Institutional Planning and Assessment Office staff in the preparation, review, and dissemination of accreditation reports. The Associate Dean also serves as the university liaison to CAEP, CTC and other accrediting agencies.

The ideal candidate will have the following qualifications:

- Earned doctorate in education or related discipline (preferred, not required)
- Advanced knowledge of CAEP, CTC and WASC accreditation processes
- Significant experience in state, regional, and/or national accreditation
- Demonstrated ability to serve effectively and collegially as a member of the Dean's Leadership Team
- Ability to provide effective leadership and to work with diverse groups
- Excellent oral and written communication skills
- Strong interpersonal skills
- Technology skills relevant to academic administration and assessment
- Minimum of 5 years of administrative experience in higher education
