

Education: Secondary Education-Assistant Professor

CI is accepting applications for a tenure track secondary level teacher educator with specialization in the following areas: history/social science, or science (any discipline). The successful candidate will be responsible for teaching courses at the post-baccalaureate and MA levels; included are middle school and high school methods in the content area, courses in the MA in Education (Curriculum & Instruction specialization), as well as supervising credential candidates in the field. Position may include the teaching of courses in subject matter preparation at the undergraduate level. Additional tenure track responsibilities include developing, maintaining or expanding a scholarly research agenda and service to the program, community, and university.

Required Qualifications:

A Doctoral degree in Education or a related field, or ABD with a completion date no later than August 2017.

Record of successful credentialed middle and/or high schools teaching for a minimum of three years, with demonstrated effectiveness in teaching multi-ethnic, multicultural and/or multi-lingual students using a variety of methods and technologies

Commitment to student success and diversity

Record of positive relationships with school district personnel, students, and families

Evidence of commitment and ability to work in teams

An emerging record of scholarship in one or more areas of emphasis in secondary education

Evidence of commitment to one's own discipline and to the broader institution

As a condition of employment, this position will require a background check. The person holding this position is considered a 'mandated reporter' under the California Child Abuse and Neglect Reporting Act and is required to comply with the requirements set forth in CSU Executive Order 1083 as a condition of employment.

Preferred Qualifications:

Experience in and commitment to ongoing, outcomes based, program assessment of teaching and learning

Professional expertise and demonstrated excellence in teaching secondary methods and clinical teaching supervision at the university level

University level experience in curriculum planning and development

Knowledge of regional and national accreditation processes and preparation of required documentation

Proficiency in on-line or blended teaching and course development
